- ➤ To work within the community nursery's First Steps Bath Safeguarding and Child Protection procedures, inclusion policy and confidentiality policy.
- ➤ To share tasks necessary as part of the general upkeep, tidiness and cleanliness of the community nursery environment and resources, and which contribute to the general well-being of the team.
- Where appropriate to participate in and contribute to regular staff meetings, appraisals and training including INSET days to improve skills and knowledge and develop a positive attitude that enhances practice.
- > To maintain a high level of professionalism, both inside and outside the nursery.
- > To undertake any other tasks, as requested by the management team, that are necessary for the smooth running of the nursery and the welfare of the children in its care.
