**First Steps Bath**

Here at First Steps Moorlands community nursery we offer a welcoming and secure environment for young children and their families.

We have a 55 place nursery which provides day care and education for children aged from babies to 5 years (and up to 8 years after school or in the holidays).

We are open from 8.00am to 6:00 pm on Monday to Friday all year round.\*



#### First Steps Moorlands Community Nursery offers:

- Purpose built space with separate rooms for different age groups
- The children have an outside garden and covered play space which they can use whatever the weather
- The nursery is fully accessible and we pride ourselves in being an inclusive setting
- Funded places for children (Early years entitlement/30 hours)



#### We offer the child:

- Loving care in a safe and stimulating setting
- Play based on activities appropriate to the age of the child
- The support of a personal key person
- The opportunity to socialise with children and adults
- High quality play equipment, toys and books
- Free meals for families on low income

#### We offer the parent / carer:

- A friendly, welcoming and positive environment
- The opportunity for parents to be involved with their child's learning; from reading a story to becoming a volunteer

#### As a early years centre we work in partnership with other Professionals.....

- From health, social care, education and other voluntary organisations



#### Meals:

When the cost of the meal is not included in the session price, they are charged as follows: Mid morning snack 80p, Lunch £3.30, Afternoon light tea 80p. It should be noted that no EYE hours include the cost of meals and these will be invoiced monthly in advance.

We fundraise to ensure that families on low income have free hot meals for their child.
